In May 2020, the community passed the five-year \$88 million bond for infrastructure and other improvements within the school district.

As shared in recent Board of Education bond updates, we are seeing that economic pressures in construction are pushing our costs to build projects significantly higher, thus leaving tough decisions for our school board.

## Special Meeting - October 11, 2022

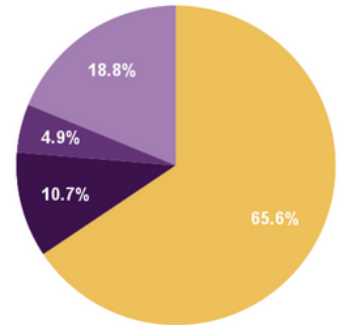
The CCS Board of Education has decided to move forward with **finishing the list** of projects remaining in the 2020 Bond and place a supplemental bond issue on the ballot for a new Dutton Elementary.

## Supplemental Bond

### Special Meeting - November 9, 2022

The CCS Board of Education has decided to pursue a **\$61 Million supplementary bond** for a new Dutton Elementary and other priority facility projects that were previously removed.

- **New Dutton Elementary - 65.6%**
- **Calplex = 4.9%**
- **Stadium Renovation - 10.7%**
- **Other Priority Projects - 18.8%**
