



# Transforming Michigan's Internet Infrastructure Together

#### Do you have a poor internet connection at home? There may be hope on the horizon!

We know that depending on where our families live, not all of our students have access to reliable, high-speed internet at home. To help address this issue, Michigan has received more than \$1.5 billion in federal infrastructure funding for improved internet access.

CCS encourages our families in underserved areas to make sure your household is represented! Through Tuesday, April 23, residents can review the information about their home internet service that decision-makers are using when allocating these resources. In some cases, that information may not be accurate, so until April 23 residents can verify their address and report any discrepancies as part of the State of Michigan's Broadband Mapping Challenge.



To ensure your household is accurately represented, **check your address** on the state challenge map **by April 23!**

# DLMS ATHLETICS

In order to participate on a school-sponsored sports team, your student-athlete must be registered on Final Forms. If you were registered for the 2022-23 school year, you will need to review your information and update as needed for the 2023-24 school year. You will also need to sign the forms for the 2023-24 school year. An updated athletic physical (signed and dated by the physician on or after 4/15/2023) will also need to be uploaded in order for your student-athlete to be cleared to try out and/or participate on school-sponsored teams.

# **DLMS ATHLETICS**

#### 🛸 Final Forms Registration

All student-athletes are required to be registered in our online athletic registration program. We are partnered with *Final Points*, an online forms and data management service. *Final Points* allows you to complete and sign athletic participation forms for your students online. The most exciting news is that *Final Points* saves data from season-to-season and year-to-year, meaning that you will never need to enter the same information twice! You will review your information once per school year to verify the information is correct and sign the forms (if you have registered your athlete before). Using *Final Points* is a one-stop-shop for the entire registration process. On the Athletics homepage, you will see a link for the "Parent Playbook" which gives you step by step instructions through the registration process. The registration link is: **https://caledonia-mi.finalforms.com**. Registration for all school sponsored athletic teams for the 2023-2024 school year will be open on June 5.



All athletes are also required to have a completed Athletic Physical uploaded on Final Forms as well. This physical needs to be completed, signed and dated by the physician on or after April 15, 2023.



Payment for athletics is not required until after the 1st scheduled competition. You will be notified by Final Formus when payment is due. At this point you will have 1 week to pay. If payment is not received within this 1 week window, your child will not be able to continue participating until payment is received.

#### FREE meals for all enrolled CCS students for the 2023 - 2024 School Year

### What is provided...

All students attending Caledonia Community Schools are eligible for free breakfast and lunch during the 2023-24 school year. This is due to the new "Free Meals for All" legislation passed by the State of Michigan this year.



Although regular meals are free for all students, a la carte selections will still carry a charge. Parents have online access to view student balances, histories, and make deposits at any time.



## It's more than just free meals...

Even though lunches are free, families are still highly encouraged to complete the free or reduced lunch application since other funding and grant eligibility for the district is tied to these applications. For qualifying families, this application also reduces pay-to-participate fees for student-athletes and provides the district with discounted rates on internet services and network equipment purchases.

The Federal Free/Reduced Meal Application determines the amount of federal funding for the district, impacting **ALL** students.

A new application is **REQUIRED** each school year. So, even if you applied a year ago, a new application must be submitted for the 2023-24 school year. Applications are accepted after July 1 for the 2023-24 school year.
