In this informational letter please find the guidelines for building placement, program eligibility, classroom and teacher placement. For more information please visit our calschools.org district website.

Building Placement

All newly enrolled elementary students will be automatically placed in the school for which they are zoned. In January 2020, the district began transitioning to a new system for building placement that is based on geographic boundaries for each elementary school. Each home address in the district was assigned an attendance zone with a designated elementary building serving those residences.

If you have an older student who attends an elementary school other than your zoned school, and you want your kindergarten student placed with that student, you will need to apply for an [In District Transfer](#) for your incoming Kindergarten student. **The window to request that transfer is February 1, 2024 through March 12, 2024.**

Program Eligibility

According to Michigan Compiled Law (MCL 380.1147 and 388.1606) enrollment age for incoming Kindergarten students is as follows for the 2024-2025 school year:

- 5 years old on/before September 1, 2024.
- Early Entry: If a child is not 5 years of age on/before September 1, 2024 but will be 5 on or on/before December 1, 2024, the district may enroll the child for that school year at the request of a parent. Caledonia Community Schools considers completed enrollment forms a request for early entry.

Kindergarten: Any student who turns 5 years old on/before September 1, 2024 but not later than December 1, 2024 is age eligible for Kindergarten. Kindergarten meets five full days a week and follows the district calendar. Transportation is provided to and from your zoned school.

Young Fives: Any student who turns 5 years old between May 1, 2024 but not later than December 1, 2024 is age eligible to participate in our [Young Fives](#) program. The district's Young Fives classrooms are located at our Duncan Lake Early Childhood Center (DLECC), meet five full days a week, and follow the district calendar. Transportation is provided.

Uncertain of Placement: If you select 'undecided' when enrolling your child, you will be contacted by our Enrollment Coordinator. You may want to consider one of our many preschool programs at DLECC if your child turns 5 years old AFTER September 1, 2024.

Prior to 1/1/2019	Eligible	Ineligible
1/2/2019 thru 4/30/2019	Eligible	Ineligible
5/1/2019 thru 12/1/2019	Eligible	Eligible

If the interest in a particular program exceeds availability, Caledonia Community Schools reserves the right to assign students based on their birthdate.

Classroom Teacher Assignments: Classroom teacher assignments will be communicated to parents directly from their assigned building during the summer. Please refer to your assigned school's website for more information regarding their start of school year plans.
